February in My Rose Garden *by Mary Ann Hext, Master Rosarian*

Finally on the first day of February, we are predicted to have a brief break from the freezing temperatures of the past few weeks, but then snow returns in a few days. My roses seem to be surviving all the temps in the teens each night and the occasional single-digit wind chills. Some things I am doing in February are:

- Attending the Tenarky Winter Workshop—our first in two years! My registration has been mailed, and I am excited about seeing rose friends from across the district in person and hearing some excellent speakers invited to present seminars this year.
- Preparing for the CR school on Sunday morning of the workshop.
- Looking over photos of roses that I hope K&M will be bringing to sell at the winter workshop.
- Spraying lime sulfur on my bushes February 1 as the temperatures will be above freezing all day. This will be my second application as the first was in December. I have not applied this to my roses for about ten years, so it will be interesting to see if it helps my bushes to have less blackspot.
- Making a list of rose products I need to order from NRS Vendor Day and from other sources as I depleted several things last fall and am planning to revise my spray and fertilizer programs.
- Completing the BGRS rose show schedule to upload to the Tenarky website by March 1 so our members and other exhibitors can be planning for the May 21 rose show.
